New Orleans man suffers broken leg after fleeing deputies

A New Orleans man driving a stolen vehicle suffered a broken leg after fleeing from St. Bernard Sheriff's Office deputies attempting to make a traffic stop, Sheriff James Pohlmann said.

Corey Greathouse, 28, of the 1400 block of Clouet Street, was transported to University Medical Center to be treated for a broken leg after he led deputies on a chase into New Orleans and jumped into an empty drainage canal while trying to flee on foot.

After Greathouse is treated for non-life threatening injuries, he will be transported to St. Bernard Parish Prison to be booked with possession of stolen property, flight from an officer and reckless operation.

At approximately 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 21, Sheriff Pohlmann said, deputies responded to a call about a white 2004 Mitsubishi Outlander listed as stolen out of New Orleans being spotted in Arabi.

Deputies attempted to make

a traffic stop on the vehicle near the intersection of Judge Perez Drive and Rowley Boulevard, but the driver, later identified as Greathouse, refused to stop and led deputies on a pursuit into the Ninth Ward in New Orleans.

When Greathouse came upon an impassable construction site near the corner of Alvar Street and Florida Avenue, he abandoned the stolen vehicle and fled on foot. While fleeing from

Mandeville Couple claims \$1.8 million Lotto ticket with only two-weeks to spare

One Mandeville couple has over a million new reasons to be thankful this week. Harold and Tina Ehrenberg claimed the sole \$1.8 million jackpot-winning ticket for the June 6 Louisiana Lottery Lotto drawing, which they recently discovered while doing some holiday cleaning.

"We have family coming into town for Thanksgiving, so I was cleaning up the house and found a few Lottery tickets on my nightstand that we hadn't checked," Tina recalled during the couple's trip to Lottery headquarters on Nov. 19.

The pair quickly visited the Lottery's website to see if they were winners and realized one Lotto ticket matched all of the numbers listed. "We kept checking the numbers again and again!" Harold explained. "Plus, I called the winning numbers hotline over and over," Tina added.

After realizing their good fortune, Harold began counting down the days from the drawing, realizing there was a deadline to claim the prize. "I kept waiting for something to go wrong," Harold recalled.

The Ehrenbergs claimed their prize just in time, as the giant jackpot-winning ticket was set to expire only two weeks later. Prizes for draw-style games must be claimed within 180 days of the drawing in which the prize was won.

The winning ticket was purchased at International Market on Barron Street in Metairie. The store received a one-time selling bonus of \$17,948.07, which is 1 percent of the prize.

The winners received \$1,274,313 after state and federal tax withholdings, which they plan to put away for retirement. "We don't have any plans to buy anything crazy or go on any big trips," Tina explained. "The most fun is going to be depositing that check!" Harold added.

The winning numbers for the June 6 Lotto drawing were 03-07-30-31-35-38.

Lotto ticket purchasers must be at least 21 years of age. Draw-style game tickets must be claimed within 180 days of the drawing. Anyone who may have a gambling problem or friends and family of anyone with a gambling problem should call toll free 1-877-770-7867 for help.

For security purposes, the Lottery strongly encourages players to sign the back of their tickets immediately after purchasing. More information about Lotto can be found on the Lottery's website, www.louisianalottery.com/lotto.

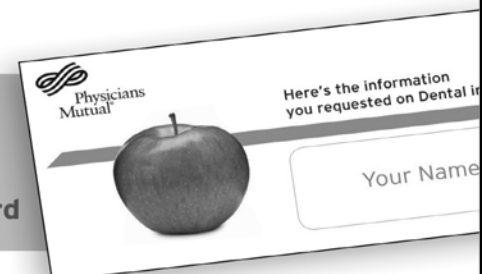

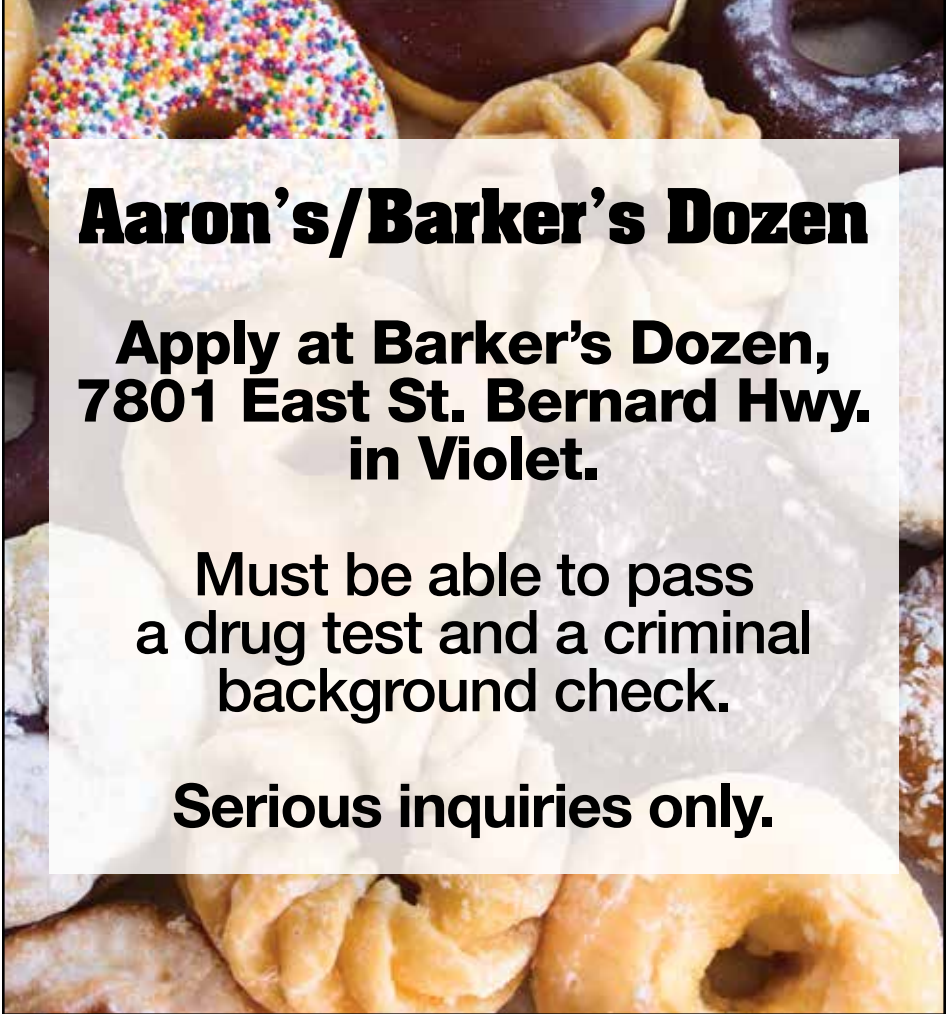

Breaux was found to be in possession of five small clear plastic bags containing cocaine, one clear plastic bag containing heroin, and two home-made glass smoking devices.

Breaux was transported to St. Bernard Parish Prison to be booked.

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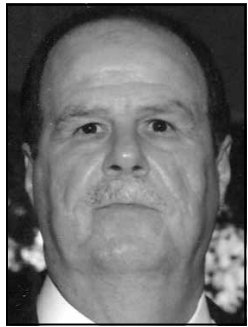

As agents executed the search warrant at the Trio Street residence, two male subjects, later identified as Lee and LeBlanc, fled the home through a second floor window, leaving behind LeBlanc's 2-year-old child he shares with Tierian Glenn. Both Lee and LeBlanc were apprehended nearby.

Agents also recovered three additional handguns, including a Sig Sauer P250 .9mm, a Springfield XDM .45 caliber, and a Glock 17 .9mm.

Barbain and Tierian Glenn were both present at the home and were booked on the above listed charges.

A criminal history check was conducted on all subjects which revealed Justin Glenn, Mahogany and Lee all have prior felony convictions.

Parish Officials celebrated a Ribbon Cutting for the Delacroix Island Shipyard located at 5565 Delacroix Highway, St. Bernard.

The Meraux Foundation donated waterfront property for the new pier as well as property across the highway for the newly-dedicated shipyard. Located close to fishing waters, vessels will not need to travel as far inland for repairs. This short-

er trip will save fishermen time and money.

"Fishermen are the backbone of the St. Bernard Parish economy, and they play an important role in preserving our culture. That's why we are so proud to donate this land so that it might be of a benefit to them," said Rita Gue, the president of the Meraux Foundation.

The new pier includes a pavilion and underwater lights for

fishing. It is free and open to the public seven days a week around the clock. With the new dry dock and shipyard, large vessels can be lifted out of the water and brought across the highway to a fenced-in shipyard.

"We're so proud of what we did down here in Delacroix through the leadership of our Council, in particular, Council Member Montelongo...and to partner with the Meraux Foundation — as we do all over the parish — to enhance the quality of life," said St. Bernard Parish President Guy McInnis. "To have this dry dock where our commercial fishermen can work on their boats in their community and get them back faster

means a lot to us, and we thank the Meraux Foundation for making that happen."

McInnis pointed out the importance of the fishing industry outside of levee protection to the long term viability of St. Bernard Parish. This is one of the most significant commercial fishing areas in Louisiana according to Louis Pomes, an official with the Department of Public Works who oversaw the construction of the pier.

"This shipyard is very important to commercial fishermen," said Pomes, who explained that, before the shipyard opened, fishermen could lose a day's work traveling further inland to dry dock and getting materials to fix their boats.

"It couldn't have been done without them. We couldn't have had the dry dock, we couldn't have had the boat trolley slip, we couldn't have had the pier over the water without the donation from the Meraux Foundation," said Pomes.

President McInnis and others recognized the leadership of Parish Council Member Manuel "Monty" Montelongo who led the effort to build the pier and shipyard.

"There are lots of people who need to be thanked for this project. This has been a dream in my mind for the last ten years, ever since I started thinking about running for office, said Montelongo. "We've needed this for a long time; it's always been in my heart to do it."
