Sheriff's Office Investigating Shooting In Chalmette

The St. Bernard Sheriff's Office is investigating a shooting that occured Saturday shortly before midnight in Chalmette, Sheriff James Pohlmann said.

On Saturday, May 1, at approximately 11:45 p.m., Sheriff Pohlmann said, deputies responded to a call about a shooting at the intersection of Juno Drive and Patricia Street in Chalmette.

When deputies arrived on the scene, they observed a male victim lying on the sidewalk near the corner of Juno and Patricia with a gunshot wound to his right side. Deputies also found another male victim on Patricia Street who had been shot in the left foot.

The two juveniles, ages 15 and 16, told deputies they were walking on Patricia Street toward Juno Drive when the occu-

pants of a dark in color SUV traveling eastbound on Patricia began shooting at them. The vehicle fled eastbound on Patricia Street toward Paris Road.

Both victims were transported to University Medical Center to be treated for their injuries. The 15-year-old who was shot in his side is reported to be in stable condition. No information was available on the 16-year-old who was shot in the foot.

Sheriff Pohlmann said no one else was injured in the incident, and the investigation is ongoing.





Sheriff's Office Arrests Chalmette Woman On Narcotics Charges

The St. Bernard Sheriff's Office arrested a Chalmette woman on various narcotics charges following an investigation conducted by the Special Investigations Division Narcotics Unit, Sheriff James Pohlmann said.

Tiffany Holmes, 32, of the 200 block of Marina Road in Chalmette, was booked with possession with the intent to distribute marijuana, possession with the intent to distribute THC, and possession of crack cocaine.

After obtaining information that Holmes was involved in illegal drug activity in St. Bernard, Narcotics Unit agents opened an investigation. Based on their findings, agents obtained a search warrant for her residence, Sheriff Pohlmann said.

During the investigation, agents recovered 50 pounds of high grade marijuana with an estimated street value of \$175,000, 431 THC vapes with an estimated street value of \$43,000 and a small amount of crack cocaine.

Agents also recovered more than \$4,300 in cash. Holmes was transported to the St. Bernard Parish

Holmes was transported to the St. Bernard Parish Prison to be booked on the above charges.



Ochsner Hospital for Children Opens Multi-Disciplinary Autism Clinic at the Michael R. Boh Center for Child Development

Autism spectrum disorder affects one in every 54 children in the United States, making access to healthcare resources critically important for families of children with this neurodevelopmental disorder. With the opening of its new multi-disciplinary Autism Clinic, the Michael R. Boh Center for Child Development at Ochsner Hospital for Children is expanding access in the Gulf South to specialized behavioral and educational programs designed to assess and treat Autism spectrum disorder.

Housed within the Boh Center (located at 1319 Jefferson Highway and adjacent to Ochsner Health Center for Children) the new multi-disciplinary Autism Clinic is designed to assess children ages two through four years old for suspected Autism spectrum disorder. The multi-disciplinary team, which consists of a medical developmental specialist, a psychologist, a speech pathologist and a social worker, works together to complete a comprehensive evaluation and if a diagnosis is made, develops a personalized treatment plan for each patient.

"We've seen firsthand how early intervention and diagnosis of Autism spectrum disorder can improve a child's development. By gathering a team of multi-disciplinary specialists all under one roof, our goal is to streamline the assessment process to help families get the care they need," said Lee Ann Annotti, PhD, a licensed child psychologist and clinic coordinator for the Autism Assessment Clinic at the Boh Center for Child Development at Ochsner Hospital for

Children

Early signs a child may need assessment for suspected Autism spectrum disorder include:

- Language: Delayed language skills or use language in ways that are atypical, such as repeating words or phrases.
- Social Interaction: Reduced or no eye contact and/or a preference to be alone or appears withdrawn, or appears to not understand social cues and boundaries
- Play: Play doesn't use imagination, may involve only using a toy for its function or using a toy in a restricted or repetitive manner
- **Fixations:** May stick to rigid routines or sameness and/or have difficulty with transitions
- Motor Activities: May display behaviors that appear odd or purposeless, like flapping hands, pacing in circles, or rocking back and forth

"Taking care of kids and keeping them healthy is what we do best at Ochsner Hospital for Children. We started the Boh Center because we recognized the need to fill a significant gap in healthcare resources for children with special healthcare needs. Now, with the new multi-disciplinary Autism clinic, we are poised to serve more pediatric patients with the most prevalent pediatric developmental disability – here in New Orleans and across the Gulf South," said William Lennarz, MD, System Chair of Pediatrics, Ochsner Hospital for Children.

Modeled after world-class facilities, in-

cluding the Kennedy Krieger Institute in Baltimore, the Boh Center was carefully designed to create a healing, collaborative environment for children and their families. 
